National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience

NAYLE will provide Scouts with a Philmont-based wilderness encounter that motivates them to follow a life of helping others succeed based on the values expressed in the Scout Oath and Law.

What is NAYLE?

National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience (NAYLE) is an exciting program of the Philmont Training Center where young men and women enhance their leadership skills in the Philmont Backcountry. Youth will expand upon the team building and ethical decision making skills learned in National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT). NAYLE uses elements of the Philmont Ranger Training as well as advanced Search and Rescue skills to teach leadership, teamwork and the lessons of selfless service. NAYLE offers Scouts an unforgettable backcountry wilderness experience that develops leadership and teamwork skills, using the core elements of NYLT to make these skills intuitive.

What Can I Expect?

The Philmont leadership is committed to making NAYLE a very special experience. You will live in a team setting at Rocky Mountain Scout Camp, a setting that forces participants to use their leadership skills to resolve challenging backcountry situations. The week will conclude with a closing challenge for each Scout to build upon the legacy of Waite Phillips, the benefactor of Philmont Scout Ranch.

What Will I Take Home from NAYLE?

- The skill, ability, and motivation to be a dynamic and effective leader taught through advanced, practical applications of NYLT skills.
- Innovative techniques to deliver NYLT skills to units and council staffs
- Nationwide resources including new ideas and contacts that can only be gained through Philmont's unique environment
- Personal written commitment (sent to the council) to apply NAYLE Skills back home.

How Has the NAYLE Changed?

NAYLE is now open to young men and women who are registered in a troop, team, or crew and hold a unit leadership position.

Who Can Come?

Scouts must be between the ages of 14, and not yet 21, hold a unit leadership position and have completed NYLT. A NYLT to NAYLE bridge course will be available during the first quarter of 2010 for those Venturers that have not been able to take NYLT. Councils may send a council contingent, or units may send their Unit Leadership Teams. Concurrent adult training will be available most weeks at Philmont for council contingent leaders.

Where and When is it?

Sessions will be at the Philmont Training Center's Rocky Mountain Scout Camp. The 2010 program will be offered June 13-19, June 20-26, June 27-July 3, July 4-10, July 11-17, July 18-24, July 25-31 and August 1-7, 2010. The Cost for the program is \$355.

If needed, there are a small number of \$200 scholarships available by contacting your council who then will make a request from the Outdoor Adventure Program Team at the National Office. Contact your council office for more information.
